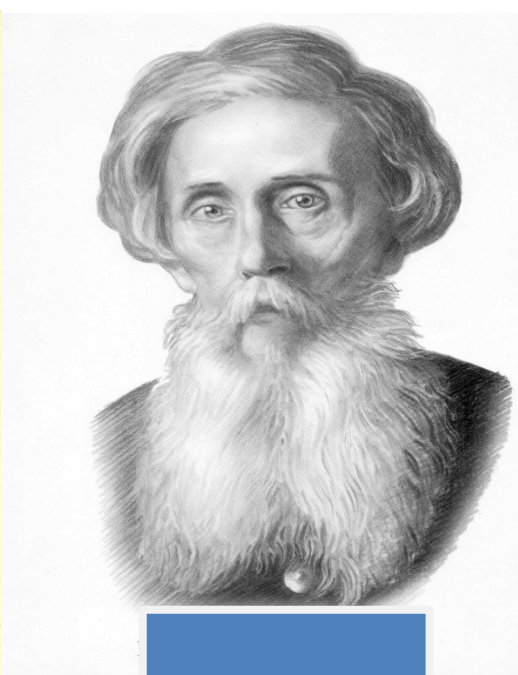

1. November 19th, 1711, in Arkhangelsk province. He was a famous Russian scientist, polymath and a writer, who had greatly contributed into national literature, science and education. He was also the founder of Russian literary language and a talented poet.
2. The greatest work of his life is the Explanatory Dictionary of the Live Great Russian Language, the first of its kind ever written or published in Russia.
3. He was born on November the 11th 1821 in Moscow. While travelling he wrote another outstanding novel “The Idiot” and started working on “Demons”. In 1866 one of his most renowned works “Crime and Punishment” was published.
